*We have had a few children attend these challenge events now and the feedback has been very positive. Do please let us know if you attend. We'd love to hear all about it!*

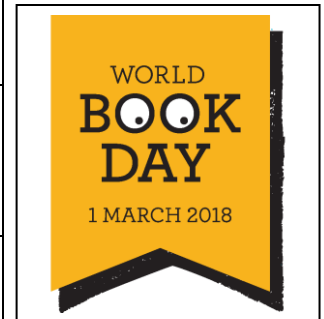
### INDEPENDENT SUPPORT SERVICE
