INTRODUCTION

Navigation Primary School Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) is a registered charity with the trustees listed within the Charity Commission as:

The objective of the PTA, as defined in the constitution, is to advance the education of pupils in the school, by: Developing effective relationships between staff, parents and others associated with the school. Engaging in activities, or providing, facilities and/or equipment which supports the school and advances the education of the children.

The constitution requires the PTA to have their account independently reviewed and the committee seeks delegated authority to appoint an appropriate independent person, as done in previous years.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Please see attached Appendix A for the full list of fundraising events and items.

Funds raised this year totalled £10, 566.48 and running costs and expenses totalling £2,981.56 with the gross income reaching £13, 548.04.

Big spend items covered this year are the new Hall Sound System (£2, 997), the Aquarium & Coral Reef Hire (£1, 428), the Reading Escape Room (£1, 353) and the VR Workshops (£1, 346).

We are pleased to have been able to fund additional books, audio books and listening stations to the library (£354,07 and £576.43 consecutively) and glockenspiels (£303,87).

The PTA continues to be Gift Aid Registered and BOPP remains in use for cashless payments, which enables us to identify events where Gift Aid can be claimed more efficiently. This year this has totalled £597.27 in passive contributions.

EVENTS & FUNDRAISERS - HIGHLIGHTS

We are pleased to have hosted events that not only have raised funds, but we hope provided an opportunity to learn something new with the following:

Lunar New year Disco which raised £664,05 with the generous donation of time and materials to create an awesome Chinese Dragon.

Eid Celebration which raised £303,21 and the donation of delicious foods, entertainment and an educational speaker.

We continued with existing fundraisers which continue to succeed, such as

Christmas Cards

Raising £438, 56 with no expenses, seeing and almost matched funding opportunity to last year.

Christmas Raffle

We were fortunate to again enjoy a wide variety of prizes to be won which contributed to £855.10 being raised. Thank you to everyone who generously sourced and donated these.

Santa's Grotto

Another event that is successful due to the team of elves who ensure this is a magical event, for even the oldest of children who visit Santa, raising £1,285.30 minus expenses of £910.91, including a gift for the gift-giver Santa and the children's gifts which were very good. This is a £110.30 increase in gross funding from last year.

Christmas and Spring Fairs

These are the most challenging and time-consuming events of the year where we heavily rely on the time and patience of our wonderful staff, parent volunteers, children, and friends to ensure these go off without a hitch, are successful and enjoyed and this year was no exception.

The Christmas Fair raised £2,294.56 (including a toy sale and own clothes days), boasting a £502 increase from last year and out Spring Fair raising £2, 653.42 (including own clothes days).

This year saw the introduction of tokens which allowed parents and carers the convenience of paying by card.

Not so New Fundraisers

In addition to this, we continue to reach out to our Volunteer WhatsApp group where any parent or carer interested in helping us with and at events can easily and quickly be recruited. We would like to thank these two groups for their continuing help and support.

We continue to feature PTA events and news in the weekly school newsletter which every parent receives via email. Where necessary we have sent separate correspondence via School Spider or notices in book bags. Closer to events we utilise reminders on the blackboards outside the school gates.
