Our commitments as staff of Navigation Primary School

LEARNING

As staff we will:

- Have high expectations of every child and believe in the ability of every child to succeed.
- Provide a broad, balanced, stimulating curriculum which inspires children to learn and grow.
- Challenge children to explore, question and be curious in their learning.
- Encourage children to take risks in their learning and support them in learning from their mistakes.

RESPECT

As staff we will:

- Practise equal opportunities and include all children, wherever possible in all activities.
- Respect and celebrate the diversity and individuality of everyone in our school.
- Be welcoming of parents and carers, involving them in the life of the school and listening to their views and perspectives.
- Deal with any issues or concerns in a fair, respectful and timely manner.

CARING

As staff we will:

- Provide a safe, calm and happy learning environment for children where children are supported and nurtured.
- Care about the safety and wellbeing of all our children and families.
- Share any concerns we have with regards to your child's behaviour, wellbeing or work.
- Encourage and support children to become independent learners.

COLLABORATION

As staff we will:

- Keep you informed about what your child is learning in school and how they are progressing.
- Involve the whole school community in activities and events and keep you informed about what is happening at school.
- Work with you to ensure your child gets the right support they need to succeed at school.
- Offer advice and support to help you to support your child with their learning.

Our commitments as parents of Navigation Primary School

LEARNING

As parents we will:

- Ensure my/ our child attends regularly and on time for 8.45 am (N), 8.50am (R) and 8.55am (KS1 & 2) and is collected promptly at 3.25pm (EYFS & KS1), 3.30pm (KS2)
- Send my/our child's book bag with the correct equipment, e.g. reading book, P.E. kit, in each day so they are ready to make the most of every learning opportunity.
- Encourage my/our child to keep going and not give up when their learning feels challenging or when they make mistakes.

RESPECT

As parents we will:

- Make sure my/our child wears school uniform and follows the school dress code.
- Avoid taking my/ our child out of school unless absolutely essential.
- Demonstrate courtesy and respect for others in the school community, raising any concern with school in an appropriate and respectful manner.

CARING

As parents we will:

- Inform school of any problems, changes or concerns that might affect my/our child's work, wellbeing, safety or behaviour.
- Support the school in implementing its policies, including the school behaviour policy.
- Encourage my/our child to try and do things for themselves so they can become more independent.

COLLABORATION

As parents we will:

- Make time to listen to my child read regularly and support them with their homework.
- Attend Parents' Evenings to discuss my/ our child's progress and support other school events where possible.
- Work with the school to ensure my/ our child gets the help they need to succeed, taking on board feedback and ideas from staff.

Our commitments as pupils of Navigation Primary School

LEARNING

As a pupil I will:

- Come to school on time every day with my book bag and look after school equipment that helps me to learn.
- Always try my best and work hard to achieve my goals.
- Keep going and not give up when things feel difficult or I make a mistake.

RESPECT

As a pupil I will:

- Wear the correct school uniform including shoes every day and always bring a coat to school.
- Show respect to everyone in school.
- Do as a grown up asks me the first time I am asked.

CARING

As a pupil I will:

- Be kind and caring and help others when they need it.
- Being a good friend to other children and ensure no-one feels left out.
- Follow all our school rules including walking around school, not rushing or pushing.

COLLABORATION

As a pupil I will:

- Tell a grown up if I am unhappy or upset.
- Listen to advice and feedback from teachers to help me to learn.
- Help my classmates with their learning when we work together.
